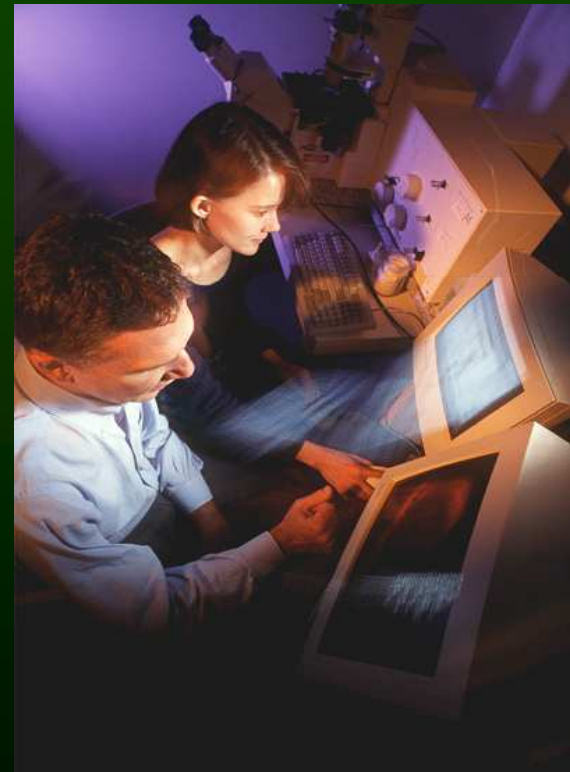
Realistic Characteristics

Artistic Characteristics

- Artistic, innovative, or intuition abilities
- Likes to:
 - Work in unstructured situations
 - Use imagination and creativity



Social Characteristics

 - Enlighten people
 - Inform people
 - Train people
 - Cure people
 - Skilled with words



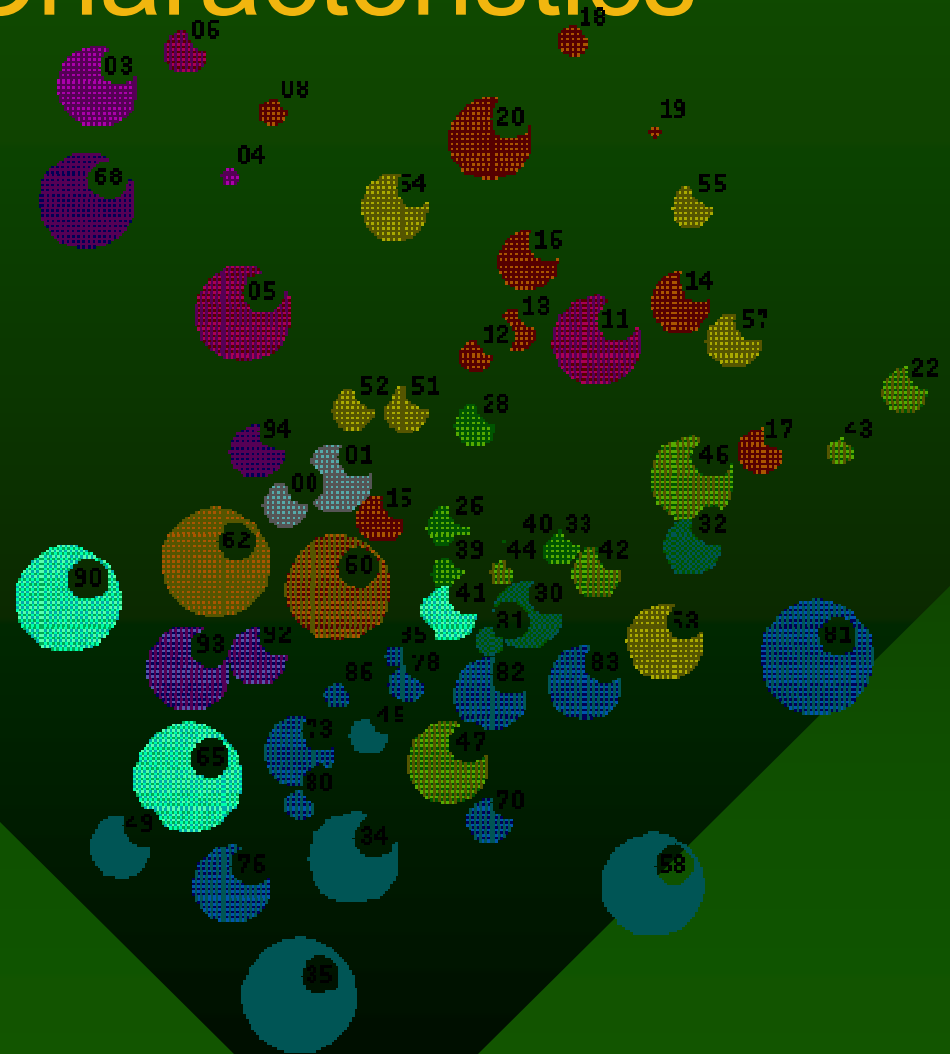
Enterprising Characteristics

 - Managing




Conventional Characteristics

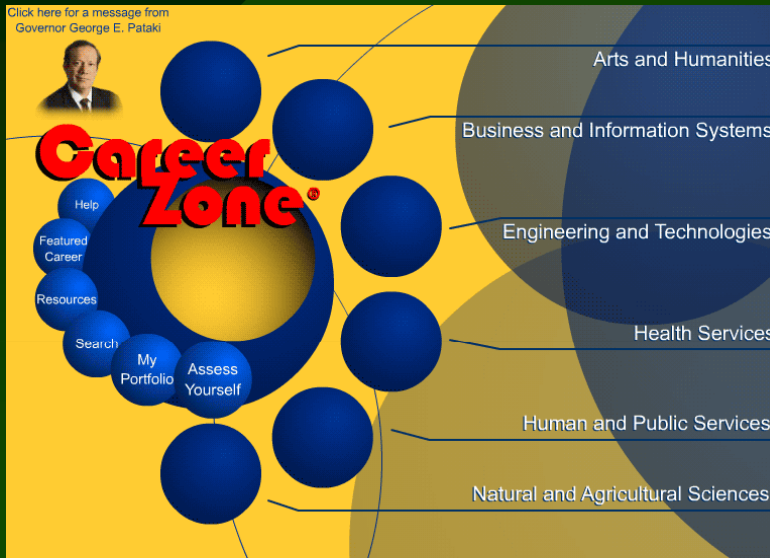
